Facts Found: 1. The course to be sailed was LA2. RC made a change of course

at the gate, signaling it with "C" flag "+" and sound signals. The new windward marks (pink) were laid before the first boat rounded the gate. The new pink marks were laid 0,1 NM to windward of the original marks. There was a big aluminum boat and two ribs around the old marks. The RC did not remove the old marks from the water because there were some competitors that have not rounded them yet. After rounding the gate ARG, AUS, AUT, BEL, BRA, CHN, DEN, FRA, GBR, GER, ITA, NZL and POL sailed to the blue windward marks (old ones) and rounded them, then they sailed directly to the finish line

and finished. CHN did not finish the race.

Conclusions: By failing to round the new windward marks (pink ones) ARG,

AUS, AUT, BEL, BRA, CHN, DEN, FRA, GBR, GER, ITA, NZL and POL did not sail the course and therefore broke rule
