Facts Found:

1. DEN gel coat on the top of the dagger board casing chipped yesterday during the practice race and it was repaired by the manufacturer.
2. DEN sailed races one and two.
3. In race three the daggerboard moved further into the daggerboard case and could not be removed.
4. DEN chose to retire from race three to prevent further damage to the daggerboard.
5. The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions state that the failure of supplied equipment will not be grounds for redress.
